


How To Book

About Laparoscopic Neutering



Many pet owners worry that neutering will cause their pet pain and discomfort.

At Brentknoll we offer Laparoscopic Spaying for bitches, a revolutionary procedure that has many advantages over traditional methods.

Did you know that most surgical procedures in human hospitals are carried out by laparoscopic (keyhole) methods? If it's good enough for us we feel our animal companions should get the same high quality treatment.

Why Choose Laparoscopy?

- **Less Pain** - The 'keyhole' technique means there is less trauma caused to both internal and external tissue. Therefore there is a lesser need for pain relief and anti-inflammatory medication. In fact most pet owners report their dogs were up and about the following day, seemingly unaffected by their surgery.
- **Smaller wounds** - We use the two port technique at Brentknoll, meaning your pet will have only two small 1cm incisions (traditional methods involved a 10cm incision.) This significantly reduces the risk of infection, complications with swelling/bleeding and most have little to no bruising.
- **Reduced period of 'rest'** - Since there are no large wounds and pain is minimal, dogs are able to return to normal activity much quicker than with traditional surgical methods. Most dogs are able to lead walk after 4 - 5 days (traditional methods recommend animals are kept quiet for 10 days.)

All prices are inclusive of pre-anaesthetic medication, pain relief, IV catheter, general anaesthetic, surgery time, suture material, Petsaver collar and one Post op check with the nurse
